THE CURRENT VERSION OF USGA RULES  
AND THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

1. Out of Bounds: Defined by white stakes, retaining walls, street curbs, and homeowner fences or property lines typically evidenced by a change in the landscape rock. Any ball that goes into or crosses a street is OB. The driving range area between holes #1 and #9 of the West Course is OB. Rule 18.2 applies.
2. Penalty Areas: All lakes and the wash crossing #15 East are red penalty areas. A ball drop zone is provided on #13 East as an additional option to those available under Rule 17.1d. All the area between the right edge of the cart path and the course boundary to the right of #9 West is a red penalty area. A ball that comes to rest in this area may be played as it lies or, for one penalty stroke, the player may take relief under one of the options listed in Rule 17.1d, using the point where the ball last crossed the edge of the penalty area as the reference point for defining the relief area. The point where the ball is dropped may not be closer to the hole than that reference point.
3. Abnormal Course Conditions: Ground under repair is encircled with white paint. French drains are GUR even though not marked. River rocks (typically softball-size and greater) closely arranged for a functional purpose such as drainage or erosion control are an obstruction. If such an area of rock is adjacent to another obstruction such as a cart path, they are deemed to be part of the same obstruction. The rock landscaped area within the path at the cart turnaround near the green on #7 East is part of the cart path. Worn areas through desert areas caused by vehicle traffic are not obstructions except for the cart exit path bordered by river rock on #12 East. Staked trees with wire or rope supports are obstructions. Rule 16.1 applies.
4. Immovable Obstruction Near a Green: For a ball in the general area, in addition to relief for interference under Rule 16.1b, free relief is available if an immovable obstruction within 2 club-lengths of the green and within 2 club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play.

PEBBLECREEK RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Course Rangers have the authority to enforce all PebbleCreek rules. Repeated violations may lead to expulsion.
2. Proper golf dress is required. No metal spikes allowed.
3. Players may not enter homeowner property to retrieve golf balls.
4. Carts must remain on the cart path on all par 3 holes and any other hole designated as cart path only. Golf carts are never allowed in the desert, on homeowner lots, or in any red penalty area.
5. Please fill divots with sand and seed mix, repair ball marks, and rake bunkers.
6. All yardages are measured to the middle of the green.

FLAG COLORS: RED=Front, WHITE=Middle, YELLOW=Back
